Presentation on *The Postal History of Wayne County*

Fred Donley of Shreve will be the featured speaker at our annual meeting. Donley is now retired, but made his living building modern log homes. As a favor to the Kidron Community Historical Society, and particularly his long-time friends, Wayne Liechty and Ray Leisy, Donley advised Abe Troyer on chinking and finishing the Tschantz Log Cabin in Sonnenberg Village.

Donley collects just about anything historic relating to Wayne County, from pencils to buildings. One of his passions is the history of Wayne County post offices, and Donley has accumulated a vast collection of postmarks from these post offices. Dating from 1812 to the present, his more than 100 different postmarks are

the most known to be assembled.

Obviously, many of the towns no longer exist. For example, do you know where the towns of Buffalo or Moscow were located? And it seems more Wayne County post offices may be closing in the near future, so other postmarks in his collection may be added to those post offices designated as “no longer exists.”

Donley illustrates the history of postmarks, letters and post offices in an entertaining manner with his wealth of information and examples. This fascinating presentation on *The Postal History of Wayne County* should not be missed. Join us at the Heritage Center on Tuesday evening, February 28, at 7:00.

Allyson Leisy is serving as curator of our 2012 exhibit and we anticipate a fascinating display from the Kidron-Sonnenberg past.

The exhibit will open following the annual members banquet on April 24 and run through December 29.

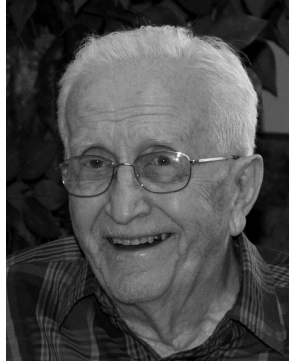
Three docents remembered
